

#### **Dutch Language Training Subsidy**

Would you like to receive a subsidy for improving the Dutch language skills of your (international) employees? There is an attractive subsidy scheme available: "Tel mee met Taal".

### What does the subsidy scheme "Tel mee met Taal" entail?

A good command of Dutch is important. Obviously for the Dutch, but less obvious for employees who come from abroad. But those who master the language feel more comfortable and function better. Investing in language skills is therefore good for both employees and employers. To encourage this, the government has developed the subsidy scheme "Tel mee met Taal". You can receive a subsidy of up to 67% to cover Dutch language training.

# When does the "Tel mee met Taal" subsidy scheme start?

The new application period for the subsidy scheme starts on 1st January 2022. Applications can be made between 1st January and 28th February 28, 2022.

## What are the main points of the "Tel mee met Taal" subsidy scheme?

The most important points for employers at a glance:

- A subsidy, up to a maximum of 67% of the eligible costs.
- A maximum of €1,500 subsidy is available per training program, per participant.
- Participants must have a current language ability level lower than B1 within the Common European Framework of Reference or lower than 2F.

### How can I apply for the subsidy?

The subsidy application is made via www.telmeemettaal.nl. However, a subsidy application requires customization. You need to know the language levels of employees and to have devised appropriate training plans. STE Languages is happy to support you in this.
